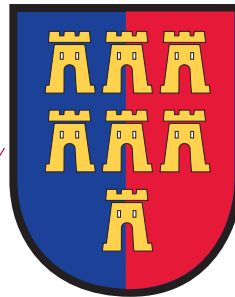

Today we are giving you an update on the Transylvania Choir concert. As you will have read before, it will take place on April 14, 2018, at the Alpine Club.

Doors open at 12 noon, Schnitzel lunch starts at 12:30, and immediately following coffee and baked goods we will start the concert. As of Feb. 6th, three Choirs have accepted our invitation, St. Catharines Heidelberg-Rheingold, Oshawa Loreley, and Hamilton Germania, one spot is still open.

All seating is by reservation only, our club members and friends get preferred seats across the front, but as soon as the entries from our visiting choirs are received, they, too, get assigned seats. That means if you wait too long, you will not be seated at the best available seats.

The cost is \$ 30 per person. There is no separate price for the concert only.
